

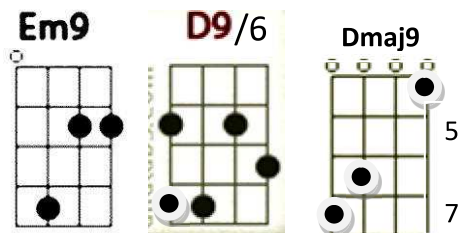
A Horse With No Name
