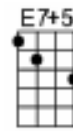

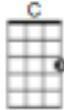

let me down (Let me down) and mess me around



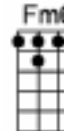
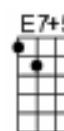
And then worst of all (Worst of all), you never call baby

Don't break my heart

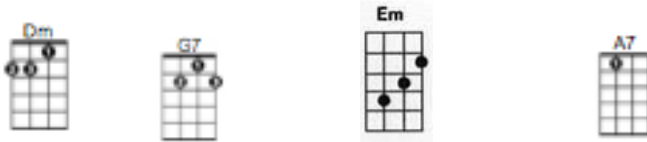


I'll be over at ten; You tell me time and again, but you're late; I wait around and then



I run to the door, I can't take any more It's not you, you let me down again

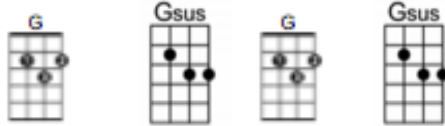
