Hello, Aloha! How are you? I'm happy to find you still waiting for me.



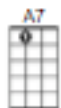
Now I can uke, and uke, and uke, and uke,



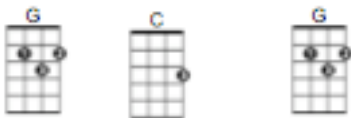
And you can uke a ukulele, too.



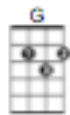
And I can wick, and you can wack,
