So, how's about savin' all your time for me?

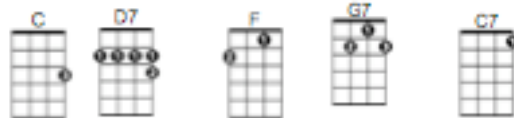
