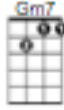

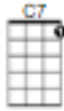
What a beautiful day for fishin' the old Hawaiian Way

Oh, we're going to the Hukilau. Huki Huki Huki Huki Huki Hukilau.



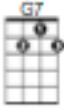
Everybody loves the Hukilau,



Where the lau lau is the kau kau at the Hukilau.

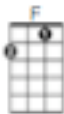
