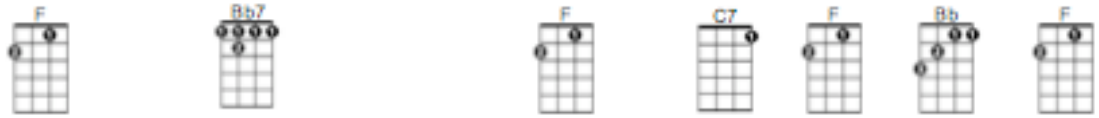

I'll go out walking after midnight out in the moonlight just like we used to do



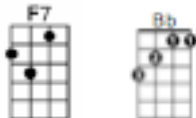
I'm always walking after midnight searching for you

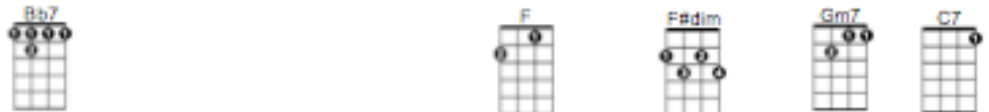

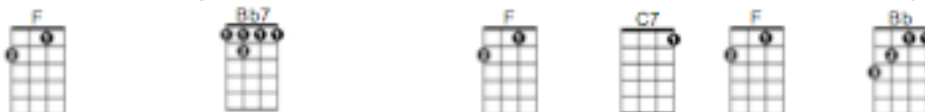

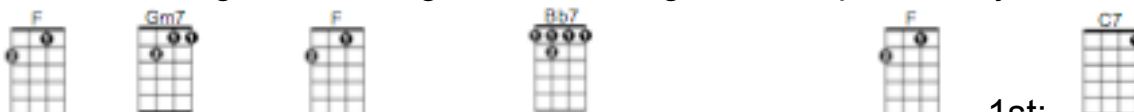
